O P I N I O N

Greyhound Lines, Inc., requests authority to conduct special operations between North Palmdale Junction and Lake Los Angeles and between South Palmdale Junction and Lake Los Angeles.

It is alleged that the Lake Los Angeles Development Company is presently developing a 400-acre area at Lake Los Angeles, located approximately 163 miles northeast of downtown Los Angeles and the company has requested applicant to provide special operations for groups of passengers in lieu of charter-party service.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Greyhound Lines, Inc., authorizing the establishment and

operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Original Page 34-C, attached hereto and made a part hereof, as an extension and enlargement of and consolidation with, and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in, the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 as heretofore amended is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Original Page 34-C referred to in ordering paragraph 1 hereof.

3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.

- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98-A.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

From junction California Highway 14 and California Highway 138 (North Palmdale Junction), over California Highway 138 to junction 47th Street East, thence over Palmdale Boulevard to junction 90th Street East, thence over 90th Street East to junction East Avenue O, thence over East Avenue O to junction 170th Street East, thence over unnumbered highway to Lake Los Angeles. ✓

Service is authorized to be conducted in Special Operations only.

No express shall be transported over this route.

*13.27 - Between South Palmdale Junction and Lake Los Angeles:

From junction California Highway 14 and East Avenue S (South Palmdale Junction), over East Avenue S to junction California Highway 138, thence over California Highway 138 to junction East Avenue T, thence over East Avenue T to junction 90th Street East, thence over 90th Street East to junction East Avenue R, thence over East Avenue R to junction 110th Street East, thence over 110th Street East to junction Palmdale Boulevard, thence over Palmdale Boulevard to junction 150th Street East, thence over 150th Street East to junction East Avenue Q, thence over East Avenue Q to junction 180th Street East, thence over 180th Street East to junction East Avenue M, thence over East Avenue M to junction 170th Street East, thence over 170th Street East and unnumbered highway to Lake Los Angeles. ✓

No express shall be transported over this route.
