FOURTH ORDER EXTENDING TIME

County of Monterey has requested an extension of time within which to comply with ordering paragraphs 2 and 3 in Decision No. 69868, as amended, as follows:

- (1) With respect to the crossing at Milepost 95.0, extend time until August 1, 1968.
- (2) With respect to the crossings at Mileposts 130.5 and 132.3, extend time until November 1, 1969.

The county alleges that the automatic gates required by Decision No. 69868 have been installed at Milepost 95.0 and that the additional time is required to complete improvement to the crossing approaches after formation of an assessment district. The county also alleges that the formation of an assessment district appears to be a certainty in order to construct the proposed frontage road, thereby closing five crossings including the crossings at Mileposts 130.5 and 132.3, instead of protecting the latter two crossings.

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with ordering paragraphs 2 and 3 required in said decision for the crossing at Milepost 95.0 is hereby extended to August 1, 1968; and for crossings at Mileposts 130.5 and 132.3 until November 1, 1969.
