## O P I N I O N

Decision No. 74051, dated April 30, 1968, effective May 20, 1968, authorized transfer of a cement carrier operating authority, as defined in Section 214.1 of the Public Utilities Code, from C. C. White, Inc., doing business as White's Transportation, to M & M Transport, Inc.

By petition for modification filed May 3, 1968, M & M Transport, Inc., requests that the effective date of Decision No. 74051 be made earlier than May 20, 1968 and that permission be granted to make tariff publications effective not earlier than five days after the amended effective date of the order.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Paragraph 3 of the order in Decision No. 74051 is amended to read as follows:

"3. M & M Transport, Inc., shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates and rules governing the common carrier operations herein to show that it has adopted or established, as its own,

said rates and rules. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 117. Failure to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 117 may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision."

2. The effective date of Decision No. 74051 is amended to be the date of this order.
