ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Carl G. Eyring, Leona P. Eyring and John R. Ethington, doing business as Peoples Warehouse Co., possess a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Trowbridge.

The Commission received a letter from the co-partners of Peoples Warehouse Co., requesting that their operative right be revoked. They state that no merchandise has been offered for storage for the past five years; that the existing facilities are not suited to present methods of storing and handling agricultural products; that it would be uneconomical to rebuild the warehouse and that there are sufficient public utility warehouses in the immediate area to take care of all storage needs.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that revocation of the prescriptive operative right would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and that the tariff applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Carl G. Eyring, Leona P. Eyring and


John R. Ethington, doing business as Peoples Warehouse Co., as determined by the Commission's order dated August 16, 1960, in Case No. 6827 is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Carl G. Eyring, Leona P. Eyring and John R. Ethington, doing business as Peoples Warehouse Co., from his Warehouse Tariff No. 38, Cal.P.U.C. No. 203, on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Carl G. Eyring, Leona P. Eyring and John R. Ethington or to mail a certified copy thereof to them at their last known addresses as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent, and Peoples Warehouse Co., P.O. Box 25, Trowbridge, California, 95687.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
