ORDER DENYING REHEARING


Decision No. 73869, dated March 19, 1968, extended the time for compliance with ordering paragraph 1c. of Decision No. 73410 to June 1, 1969. The owner of the utility, by letter to this Commission, stated that he had been unable to raise the finances to install the required main. By letter dated May 3, 1968 the owner of the utility advises that flow tests of the wells show total output of 1,105 gallons per minute, and that a new well was expected to be in use in about ten days. It appears that augmentation of the well supply sustains a reasonable delay in the installation of the main required by ordering paragraph 1 c. of Decision No. 73410.

A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 73869 having been filed by Margaret Batterson, and 24 others, individually and as representatives of a class of persons similarly situated, and the Commission having considered each and every allegation thereof


and being of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been made to appear,


IT IS ORDERED that said petition for rehearing is hereby denied.


