FIRST AMENDMENT TO ORDER
OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

On August 4, 1967, the Commission issued an Order of Suspension and Investigation in Case No. 8663, suspending to and including December 4, 1967, the effective date of tariff sheets filed under The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company Advice Letter No. 9576; and on November 30, 1967, the Commission issued an Order Extending Period of Suspension to and including June 4, 1968; and on May 3, 1968, The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company filed a Supplement to Advice Letter No. 9576 requesting permanent suspension of said Advice Letter, and filed a substitute for it under Advice Letter No. 9766 to permit continuation of the investigation beyond the normal statutory limit. This matter was consolidated for hearing with Case No. 8662, Fisher Berkeley Corporation vs. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, fifteen days of hearings were held before Examiner Coffey and these matters were submitted upon docketing of the transcript on March 22, 1968. It now appears that a decision in the matters cannot be rendered by said date of June 4, 1968.

The Commission finds that the period of suspension should be extended; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operation and effectiveness of the rules and special conditions in the tariffs filed by Advice Letter No. 9766 are hereby suspended to and including September 30, 1968, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

2. The original Order of Investigation under Case No. 8663 dated August 4, 1967, shall remain in effect as to matters considered under Advice Letter No. 9766 to the same extent as under Advice Letter No. 9576.

3. Tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 9576 of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company are hereby permanently suspended.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, and to send a copy to the Fisher Berkeley Corporation.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
