ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Golden West Telephone Company, acting on behalf of its predecessor company, The Western Telephone Company, has petitioned by letter received on May 17, 1968, for an extension of time until January 1, 1969, to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 71418 to establish the Mad River Exchange area and toll rate center, setting forth in its petition that the extension is necessary because of changes in the Mad River central office due to a proposed dam for the area, and a change in type of construction to meet local building codes for snow loading. Good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of Decision No. 71418 is changed to read:

"3. The authorization granted herein will expire unless exercised on or before January 1, 1969."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 71418 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this order.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
