Application of the General Telephone Company of California and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company for authority to make certain changes in the present Los Angeles Southern Section Telephone Directories.

ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has petitioned, by letter received May 10, 1968, for an extension until September 1, 1968, to conduct further studies related to ordering paragraph 4., of Decision No. 72130, and to delay until the October 1969 directory issue any rearrangements of the Gardena telephone directory. The additional time is necessary to provide more definitive information to civic authorities and citizens in the areas of Torrance, Lomita, and San Pedro, and to summarize and analyze the study results for preparation of the company's final proposal. Good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ordering paragraph No. 4 of Decision No. 72130 is hereby changed to read:

"4. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall conduct a study of the possibility and desirability of moving the Gardena classified listings from the Compton classified section to the Torrance-Lomita-San Pedro classified section in the October 1969 directory. The results of this study, including recommendations, shall be filed with the Commission not later than September 1, 1968."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 72130 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this order.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
