OFINION

Public hearings on the application were held in Los Angeles before Examiner Rogers on March 13 and April 1, 1968, and the matter was submitted. By letter dated May 3, 1968, the Southern Pacific Company advised the Commission that the application could be granted as requested.

ORDER

In conformity with the application and the letter from the Southern Pacific Company,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The City of Los Angeles is authorized to widen and improve the grade crossing of the Burbank Branch Line of the Southern Pacific Company at Hazeltine Avenue (Crossing No. BY-458.9) substantially in 7. The changes herein provided for are to be completed within one year after the effective date of this order unless time is extended by order of this Commission.
