FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 69512, dated August 3, 1965, ordered the cost of protection and installation at the relocated crossing of 20th Street at grade across tracks of the Union Pacific Railroad, identified as Crossing No. 3-54.4-C, to be apportioned 50 percent to the County of Riverside and 50 percent to the railroad company, but did not apportion maintenance cost. The Union Pacific Railroad Company has now requested that maintenance cost be divided in the same proportion.

Decision No. 72226, dated March 28, 1967, amended a number of previous decisions in which apportionment of maintenance cost had been deferred, to provide that the cost of maintenance of automatic grade-crossing protection be divided in the same proportion as the cost of construction, pursuant to Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code, where it had been determined that the automatic protection had been constructed after October 1, 1965.

At the subject crossing, it has been determined that automatic grade-crossing protection was constructed after October 1, 1965, and it is concluded that the cost of maintaining the automatic protection should be divided in the same proportion as the cost of constructing such automatic grade crossing protection has been divided, pursuant to Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

IT IS ORDERED that the Order in Decision No. 69512 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

- "6. The cost of maintaining grade crossing protection at the public grade crossing authorized herein shall be divided equally between the County of Riverside and the Union Pacific Railroad Company, pursuant to Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code."
