In the Matter of the Application of VIRGINIA BENINI for the transfer to HIGHLAND PATTON BUS LINES, a California corporation, of a certificate of public convenience and necessity and the right to operate a passenger bus stage line in the City of San Bernardino, County of San Bernardino, and vicinity, and for a permit authorizing HIGHLAND PATTON BUS LINES to sell and issue its securities. ORDER OF REVOCATION

Highland Patton Bus Lines, a California corporation, has heretofore operated as a passenger stage corporation in the transportation of passengers in the City of San Bernardino and its vicinity. On May 20, 1968 the City of San Bernardino acquired from Highland Patton Bus Lines its passenger stage lines heretofore operated under authority granted by this Commission in Decision No. 69368. On May 20, 1968, the City of San Bernardino commenced operation of passenger stage service over the former Highland Patton Bus Lines' routes as part of its municipal bus system. Highland Patton Bus Lines no longer conducts its passenger stage service and ceased operations after May 19, 1968.

IT IS ORDERED that the operating authority granted to Highland Patton Bus Lines, a California corporation, as contained in Decision No. 69368, is hereby revoked and all of its tariffs and time-tables on file with this Commission are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
