OPINION:

Southern California Edison Company requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges conferred by franchises granted by the County of Los Angeles and the Cities of El Segundo, Long Beach, Los Alamitos, Los Angeles, Manhattan Beach and Signal Hill.

The County of Los Angeles and each of said cities has adopted an ordinance granting a franchise for a term of years as hereinafter indicated to construct, lay, operate, maintain, use, renew, repair, replace, move and remove or abandon in place a pipeline, or a system of pipelines, together with such valves, fittings, manholes, vaults, pumps and other applicances, appurtenances, attachments or equipment, for the purpose of conducting, transporting, conveying and carrying gas, oil, petroleum, water and

other substances, on, along, upon, in, under and across the public streets, alleys, highways, and public places within such county or municipal corporation as described in said ordinances, respectively:
