In the Matter of the Application of DELTA MOBILE RADIO TELEPHONE COMPANY, a corporation, (1) for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing mobile radio communications service as a public utility in the Counties of Butte, Colusa, El Dorado, Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Solano, Stanislaus, Sutter, Yolo, Yuba, and a portion of Amador, in the State of California, and (2) for authority to sell and issue shares of its common stock.

SECOND ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Delta Mobile Radio Telephone Company having requested in writing, on June 24, 1968, for an extension of the June 30, 1968 time limit for compliance with ordering paragraph No. 8 of Decision No. 70731, as established by Decision No. 73568, Order Extending Time, dated December 19, 1967 to September 30, 1968, because of delays in FCC licensing at Vallejo and access to property because of winter conditions at Lake Tahoe. The systems in Modesto, Stockton and Sacramento began service to the public on May 9, 1968. It appearing to the Commission that a three-month extension should be granted; therefore.

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with ordering paragraph No. 8 of Decision No. 70731 is extended to and including September 30, 1968.

In all other respects, Decision No. 70731 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
