O R D E R

The County of Los Angeles is hereby authorized to widen the crossing of Miles Avenue at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, identified as Crossing No. 6C-5.71, in Huntington Park, Los Angeles County, as described and substantially as shown in the application, and to relocate the track approximately 7 feet southerly at the crossing to accommodate the automatic protection. Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

The Southern Pacific Company shall bear 100 percent of the cost of preparation of the track within the widened portion of the crossing and reconstruction in the existing avenue width within lines two feet outside of rails at the relocated crossing. The applicant shall bear 100 percent of the construction costs of the widened portion of the crossing including that in the sidewalk area and also construction costs outside of lines two feet outside of rails of the relocated crossing. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Installation cost of the automatic crossing protection and the cost of shifting approximately 950 lineal feet of existing track southerly shall be divided equally between the applicant and the railroad. Maintenance cost of the automatic protection shall be divided equally between the applicant and the railroad, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

The widened portion of crossing shall not be opened to public use until the protection ordered herein is installed and operative.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
