ORDER PERMITTING INTERVENTION

Los Angeles Airways, Inc., has petitioned to intervene in the above entitled proceeding in support of the complainant, Golden West Airlines, Inc.

Petitioner states that it is permitted by exemption order of the Civil Aeronautics Board to serve any point within a fifty mile radius of the Los Angeles Post Office Terminal Annex, using rotary wing aircraft. Since some of defendant's alleged unauthorized operations are within petitioner's service area (i.e. flights from Los Angeles International Airport to Orange County Airport), it appears that petitioner has a financial and property interest which may be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.
