O R D E R

County of Ventura is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of Victoria Avenue over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, near Montalvo, Ventura County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application as amended, to be identified as Crossing No. E-402.9-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Upon completion, existing Golf Course Road Crossing (No. E-403.2) shall be abandoned and closed and existing Golf Course Road Crossing (No. BE-403.2) shall be closed to public use.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
