SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Owl Ready-Mix, a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the transportation of cement to and within the counties of Riverside and San Bernardino from any and all points of origin.

The carrier was recently merged into Owl Materials Co., a California corporation. Marshall L. McDaniel, attorney for the surviving corporation, submitted to this Commission a copy of the agreement of merger that was filed with the Secretary of State completing the aforementioned merger. Accordingly, the certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. Owl Materials Co. will also be ordered to amend the tariffs involved pursuant to General Order No. 117. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Resolution No. 13823, Sub No. 23, dated June 23, 1964, in Application No. 46451, is amended by substituting "Owl Materials Co." in place and stead of "Owl Ready-Mix."

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Owl Materials Co. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.2 of General Order No. 117.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
