ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Western Union Telegraph Company petitioned by letter received on July 5, 1968, for an extension of time of at least ninety days, to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 74283 to file a complete set of rules. Western Union sets forth in its petition that the extension is necessary because of the multitude of tariffs that must be reviewed to compile a properly composed rules schedule. Good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 74283 is changed to read:

- "1. Applicant is authorized to file in quadruplicate with this Commission on or after the effective date of this order and in conformity with the provisions of General Order No. 96-A, revised tariff schedules with rates, charges, and conditions modified as set forth in Appendix A attached to this order and, on not less than five days' notice to the public and to the Commission, to make said revised tariffs effective for all service rendered on and after July 21, 1968, except that

applicant is authorized to file revision in Schedule No. 15-T, Rules, as set forth in Appendix A and on not less than five days' notice to the public and to the Commission to make said revision effective for service rendered on and after October 31, 1968."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 74283 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this order.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
