O R D E R

The City of Richmond is hereby authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at separated grades over the track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the City of Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit A) attached to the application as amended, to be identified as 33rd Street Pedestrian Overhead, Crossing No. 2K-2.3-AD.

Clearances adjacent to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company track shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D during and after the period of construction.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties thereto, and a copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing, approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be

extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant desires to commence construction at the earliest possible date to avoid expensive delays. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
