ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 49680 to Valley Vacuum Tank Truck Service, Inc., a corporation (Valley), has been suspended since October 23, 1967, for failure to have on file the required tariffs.

James E. McCay, president of Valley, has informed the Commission by letter that the carrier discontinued all for-hire trucking operations on August 5, 1967. He requests that the operating authority be revoked.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that revocation of the certificate, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the certificate should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier

granted to Valley Vacuum Tank Truck Service, Inc., a corporation, by Decision No. 49680 dated February 16, 1954, in Application No. 34823, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Valley Vacuum Tank Truck Service, Inc., a corporation, or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Valley Vacuum Tank Truck Service, Inc., or after the above-mentioned mailing to it.
