INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission on June 25, 1968, issued its Decision No. 74310 in Case No. 5432 (Order Setting Hearing of August 31, 1965, et al. - Classification Transition Proceeding). It ordered therein that the existing classification and exception ratings in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 be redesignated in terms of the Governing Classification to become effective September 1, 1968. It further ordered that the Governing Classification henceforth be National Motor Freight Classification A-10, (NMFC A-10), thereby eliminating reference to National Motor Freight Classification A-10 (CAL), the California supplement.

Decision No. 74310, supra, did not amend the Commission's drayage tariffs, namely: City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (San Francisco drayage); Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B (East Bay drayage); Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Los Angeles drayage) and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-B (San Diego drayage). Petitioner states that the complications of maintaining two classifications and two tariff rate structures to accommodate such drayage traffic would be substantial and expensive to both shippers and carriers. It further states that interested shippers and carriers, upon submission of the major proceeding referred to above, began discussing necessary actions to eliminate such complications and expense. General agreement among interested parties has been reached concerning the desirability of obtaining similar and concurrent changes on drayage traffic to those ordered by the Commission for statewide traffic in Decision No. 74310, supra.

According to petitioner, it is filing these instant petitions for the sole purpose of converting the aforesaid drayage tariffs to NMFC A-10 in order to complete the Classification Transition Program ordered for Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 by Decision No. 74310, supra. Petitioner asserts that the proposed changes involve the same types of increases and reductions found reasonable for Tariff No. 2 by Decision No. 74310, supra, and incorporate the same interim exception ratings that are required to maintain a comparable posture in the four drayage tariffs pending final action by the Commission in its Classification Transition Program. Petitioner asks that the tariff changes, which it proposes herein, be made effective September 1, 1968, so as to be concurrent with corresponding changes that were made in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2. This procedure, petitioner declares, will greatly minimize the complications and expenses resulting from such transition to NMFC A-10.

Petitioner's proposed amendments in Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1, as shown in Exhibit A, includes the publication in a new Section No. 2-C of said tariff of the interim exception ratings on various commodities previously established in various items of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 by Decision No. 74310, supra, pursuant to requests from shipper and carrier interests, and subject to an expiration date of December 31, 1969. Petitioner suggests that substantial economies and simplifications would accrue if such items and provisions were simultaneously transferred from Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 to the proposed Section No. 2-C of Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1. Petitioner's suggestion has obvious merit and will be adopted.

Petitioner alleges that the changed circumstances which warrant the use of ratings in NMFC A-10 for Tariff No. 2 are just as apparent with respect to the four drayage tariffs. It further alleges that the adoption of the tariff changes proposed herein is fully responsive to the needs and interests of shippers and carriers alike. Petitioner avers that, to avoid major complications, the timing of these proposed changes is extremely important and justifies a common effective date of September 1, 1968.

Petitioner asks that common carriers be authorized and directed to establish in their respective tariffs effective September 1, 1968, on less than statutory notice, such modifications as may be prescribed by the Commission's orders in these proceedings, including relief from the long- and short-haul provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code. Inasmuch as the Commission's orders in these proceedings granting the proposed tariff changes would remove future application of NMFC A-10 (CAL) to the tariffs involved, petitioner requests that the Commission direct National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, to cancel said publication on or before

December 31, 1968, on not less than thirty days' notice. Petitioner further requests that the Commission's planned procedure, for ultimate disposition of matters which the proposals herein would defer, be comparable with that outlined in Decision No. 74310, supra, and that future proceedings involving exceptions to NMFC A-10 be held on a common record involving all minimum rate tariff cases involved.

Copies of the verified petitions were mailed to various chambers of commerce, shipper organizations and carrier representatives on or about June 26, 1968. The petitions were listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of June 27, 1968. No objection to the granting of the petitions has been received.

Fibreboard Corporation has informed the Commission by letter that it strongly supports petitioner's proposals herein and urges that a similar effective date of September 1, 1968, be specified in connection with the proposed establishment of NMFC A-10 as the governing classification for the Commission's four drayage tariffs involved herein.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds that:

1. The program initially established by Decision No. 66268 of November 5, 1963 (61 Cal P.U.C. 655) and carried forward in these proceedings for the gradual transition from one classification to another to govern Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A, without incorporating any substantive tariff changes therein, other than technically required, should now be concluded.

2. The classification ratings and rules named in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 are appropriate to govern the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A. The ratings and rules set forth in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 should now replace those prescribed in National Motor Freight Classification A-10(CAL) as the governing classification for said minimum rate tariffs.

3. The increases resulting from the application of the truck-oriented ratings and rules prescribed in National Motor Freight Classification A-10, in lieu of the current governing rail-oriented ratings named in National Motor Freight Classification A-10(CAL), have been shown to be justified.

4. The minimum rates resulting from the application of the class ratings provided in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 are, and for the future will be, the just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates and charges for the transportation of property by highway carriers and city carriers subject to the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A.

5. Common carriers, subject to the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B, should be authorized to adopt National Motor Freight Classification A-10 as their governing classification in lieu of National Motor Freight Classification A-10(CAL).

6. National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, should be authorized to cancel its National Motor Freight Classification A-10(CAL) on or before December 31, 1968, on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

7. The classification and exception ratings, redesignated herein as exceptions to National Motor Freight Classification A-10,

have been shown to be justified, for a temporary period, to the extent that they maintain a status quo or do not result in any appreciable changes in the level of rates or rules, other than technically required, presently set forth in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and previously found to be just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory.

8. The evidence does not demonstrate whether the aforesaid temporary exceptions to the otherwise proposed classification ratings named in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 will, in fact, for the future be appropriate or otherwise justified to govern the rates named in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A.

9. The exception ratings found to be justified herein should be authorized on a temporary basis; it being understood that those exception ratings authorized herein, pursuant to shipper and carrier requests therefor, shall not be continued in effect beyond December 31, 1969, unless such continuance is fully justified pursuant to the filing of a petition on or before June 1, 1969.

10. To the extent that the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B have been found heretofore to constitute reasonable minimum rates and rules for common carriers, as defined in the Public Utilities Act, said provisions, as hereinafter adjusted, are, and will be reasonable minimum rate provisions for said common carriers. To the extent that the existing rates and charges of said common carriers for the transportation involved are less in volume or effect than the minimum rates and charges herein designated as reasonable for said carriers, to the same extent the rates and charges of said carriers are hereby found to be, now and for the future, unreasonable, insufficient, and not justified by the actual competitive rates of competing carriers or by the costs of other means of transportation.

11. Common carriers should be authorized to make corresponding changes in their rates for the transportation of exempt commodities, commodities which are not subject to the rates in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B, to the same extent as heretofore found to be justified in those instances in which exempt commodities are transported at the level of the minimum class rates and under the same transportation conditions as those found applicable to transportation subject to such minimum class rates.

12. Where common carriers have been heretofore authorized to depart from the so-called long- and short-haul prohibitions of Article XII, Section 21, of the Constitution of the State of California and of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code, such outstanding authorities should be modified to the extent necessary to carry out the effect of the order herein.

A public hearing is not necessary. Based on the above findings, the Commission concludes that:

1. The petitions involved herein should be granted.
2. National Motor Freight Classification A-10 should replace National Motor Freight Classification A-10 (CAL) as the governing classification for Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A.
3. The classification ratings and rules named in National Motor Freight Classification A-10, except to the extent that said ratings and rules are different from and are superseded by authorized exceptions thereto contained in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B, City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1, should be adopted and approved to govern the rates and charges established by the Commission in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A.

4. The rates, rules and charges resulting from the application of the ratings and rules named in National Motor Freight Classification A-10, including the exceptions to be authorized thereto, are, and will be the just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates, rules and charges for the transportation of property by highway carriers and city carriers subject to the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A.

The procedure to be observed for the ultimate disposition of matters deferred herein shall be as follows:

1. Exceptions to National Motor Freight Classification A-10

- a. The Commission's Transportation Division staff shall, on or before December 31, 1969, be prepared to present at formal public hearing recommendations, together with complete evidence in support thereof, concerning the final disposition of those existing exception ratings named in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B, City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 which have been temporarily redesignated herein as exceptions to NMFC A-10.
- b. Public hearings to be set upon the filing of petitions therefor on or before June 1, 1969 concerning the classification ratings which have been restated as exceptions to NMFC A-10 pursuant to requests from shipper and carrier interests, subject to an expiration date.

2. Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A Class and Commodity Rates, Rules and Charges

- a. Public hearings to be set upon request pertaining to the minimum class and commodity rate structure.
- b. Tariff rules may be combined with 2.a above.

The necessary amendments to Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 and the corresponding amendments to Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, as proposed by petitioner, will be made by the order herein. Amendments to the four drayage tariffs, as proposed by petitioner, will be made by separate orders to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The ratings and rules contained in National Motor Freight Classification A-10, as amended, are hereby approved and adopted to become effective September 1, 1968, as the just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory ratings and rules to govern the minimum rates and rules promulgated by the Commission in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A; and concurrently, National Motor Freight Classification A-10, as amended, will supersede National Motor Freight Classification A-10 (CAL), as amended, as the governing classification for said tariffs.

2. The National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized to publish, on behalf of the common carriers participating in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 (CAL), as amended, the classification ratings and rules set forth in National Motor Freight Classification A-10, as amended.

3. Common carriers participating in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 (CAL), as amended, are hereby authorized to cancel their participation in said classification effective concurrently with their adoption of National Motor Freight Classification A-10, as amended.

4. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 1, 1968, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof.

5. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 1, 1968, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix B, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof.

6. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 66195, as amended, and Decision No. 31606, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the increases necessary to conform with the further adjustments herein of the aforesaid decisions.

7. Any provisions currently maintained in common carrier tariffs which are more restrictive than, or which produce charges greater than, those contained in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B are authorized to be maintained in connection with the class ratings, rates and rules authorized and directed to be established herein.

8. Carriers maintaining exception ratings expressed as a percent of a basic classification rating, and no specific conversion of such combined exception rating factor has been provided by the order herein, are hereby authorized to apply the same percentage rating factor to the aforementioned basic classification rating, as redesignated herein, for purposes of rate determination.

9. Except as otherwise provided in ordering paragraphs 7 and 8 hereof, common carriers are not to publish ratings and rules which are different from, and are superseded by, the exceptions authorized herein and set forth in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1.

10. The class rates, ratings and rules authorized and directed to be established by ordering paragraphs 2 and 6 hereof are authorized to be made applicable also for the transportation of:

- a. Commodities for which minimum rates have not been established, or
- b. Commodities which are subject to higher rates than, or more restrictive provisions than, the minimum rates or provisions otherwise applicable.

11. Tariff publications resulting in increases required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than September 1, 1968, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public; such tariff publications as are required shall be made effective not later than September 1, 1968; as to increases which are authorized but not required, the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order; and tariff publications resulting in reductions may be made effective not earlier than September 1, 1968, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

12. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

13. Common carriers are hereby authorized to depart from the tariff filing requirements of the Commission's General Orders to the extent necessary to publish tariff changes authorized or required to be made by the order contained herein.


14. The ratings and rules established herein pursuant to requests received from shippers and carriers as exceptions to the classification ratings and rules prescribed in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 shall be made subject to an expiration date of December 31, 1969.

15. National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel its National Motor Freight Classification A-10 (CAL) on or before December 31, 1968, on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

16. In all other respects said Decision No. 66195, as amended, and Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


The effective date of this order shall be August 9, 1968.

ARRANGEMENT OF TARIFF

This is a loose-leaf tariff consisting of the following sections:

- SECTION NO. 1 contains rules and regulations of general application. Except as otherwise specifically provided, the rules and regulations contained in Section No. 1 govern the ratings in Section No. 2 of the tariff.
- SECTION NO. 2 contains ratings which are exceptions to the Governing Classification.
- SECTION NO. 2-A contains Less Truckload Classes (Ratings) which are exceptions to the Governing Classification.
- SECTION NO. 2-B contains Truckload Classes (Ratings) and Minimum Weights which are exceptions to the Governing Classification.
- *SECTION NO. 2-C contains ratings which are interim exceptions to ratings in the Governing Classification (Applies only in connection with City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 2, 5, and 9-B).
- SECTION NO. 3 contains table of rates in cents per 100 pounds, based on a percent of a given rate.
