O R D E R

The State of California Department of Public Works is here-
by authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of Central
Avenue (a city street) over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company,
in the City of Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location and
substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the appli-
cation, to be identified as Crossing No. A-11.5-A. Construction and
maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to
be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of
said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by
Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within
180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree,
the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and mainte-
nance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions
of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
