ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Homer L. Myers was suspended on May 20, 1968, for failure to maintain his tariff on file in conformity with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders.

An investigation of Homer L. Myers' operations revealed that the carrier discontinued business and on January 1, 1968 sold all his equipment, retired and has been completely inactive in the transportation business since that date.

Homer L. Myers having failed to maintain his tariff on file in conformity with the Commission's minimum rate orders, and since public convenience and necessity no longer requires his services, the Commission finds these failures constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier granted to Homer L. Myers by Decision No. 51907, dated August 30, 1955, in Application No. 37094 is hereby revoked.

Local Freight Tariff No. 2, Cal.P.U.C. No. 2 of Homer Lee Myers, doing business as Homer Lee Myers Trucking, is hereby canceled as of the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Homer L. Myers or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Homer L. Myers or after the above-mentioned mailing to him unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a tariff in conformity with the Commission's minimum rate orders, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
