FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 72894, dated August 15, 1967, Sacramento Northern Railway was authorized to relocate a spur track at grade at Bridge and Plumas Streets, (Crossing No. 8-137.3), and to construct a new spur track across Reeves Avenue, (to be identified as Crossing No. 8-137.50-C), in the City of Yuba City, County of Sutter. The order provided that Crossing No. 8-137.3 be protected by pre-empted traffic signals but inadvertently did not mention the existing Standard No. 2 overhead signs (General Order No. 75-B).

The Sacramento Northern Railway has now requested authority, under the provisions of Section XI, General Order No. 75-B, to remove the Standard No. 2 overhead signs and supporting poles which obstruct the sidewalk area, and to install four Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) attached by brackets to existing line poles, maintaining such clearances as are required by General Order No. 95. Applicant alleges that such installation would eliminate the need for existing poles in an already cluttered sidewalk area.

IT IS ORDERED that the Sacramento Northern Railway is hereby authorized to remove the existing Standard No. 2 overhead crossing signs and to install four Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material at Crossing No. 8-137.3, attached by brackets to existing line poles, maintaining

such clearances as are required by General Order No. 95. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within 30 days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
