ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company has requested a six month extension of time within which to comply with certain conditions of Decision No. 72895, alleging that it will be impossible to complete the installation of automatic protection at Oleander Avenue Crossing (No. 2X-12.8) in Riverside County within the time specified.

The railway seeks, due to certain drainage problems at this crossing, an extension of time for completion of the automatic protection.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which the applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision is hereby extended to March 5, 1969.

In all other respects Decision No. 72895 shall remain in full force and effect.
