O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a lead track and a spur track at grade across Weber Avenue and to construct a lead track and two spur tracks at grade across Lincoln Street, in the City of Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. D-92.08-C and a portion of Crossing No. D-92.02-C, respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue and street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection at Crossing No. D-92.08-C shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material, and at Crossing No. D-92.02-C shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry to be served by the spur track requires immediate rail service in order to avoid expensive delay. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
