ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING
FOR FURTHER HEARING

By Decision No. 70764, dated May 24, 1966 in this proceeding, the State of California Department of Public Works was authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of West Grand Avenue over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at the Oakland Army Base in the City of Oakland, Alameda County. Said decision provided that construction and maintenance expense should be borne in accordance with agreements entered into between the parties, and that if the parties failed to agree, the Commission would apportion said expense by further order.

Applicant has informed the Commission that the parties have been unable to reach agreement on apportionment of costs and has requested that the matter be set for hearing to receive evidence on that issue.

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Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 48399 is reopened for further hearing, for the above-indicated purpose, before such Commissioner or Examiner as may be designated at a time and place to be determined.
