ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

Decision No. 72727, dated July 11, 1967 in this proceeding, authorized the Southern Pacific Company to close a private crossing at Mile Post 42.2. This closing was to take effect simultaneously with the opening of Charles Street which would involve the opening of a public spur track crossing. An advice from Southern Pacific confirmed by an inspection made by a Commission staff engineer reveals that the private crossing has been closed and the Charles Street crossing has been completed. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 8210 be, and it is, discontinued.
