FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern California Water Company, by petition filed May 8, 1968, seeks modification of Decision No. 73827 by revoking Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of that decision, dealing with allocation method to be used in accounting.

By Decision No. 73827, dated March 12, 1968, the Commission authorized increased rates in the Southwest District of Southern California Water Company. Ordering Paragraph No. 2 ordered the utility to allocate "Administrative Expenses Transferred - Credit" in its district accounting in the ratio of the annual construction in each district to the annual total utility construction.

The Commission has considered applicant's petition and is of the opinion and finds that this is a technical matter that should have further staff study and can be resolved later by an accounting directive. In the meantime, Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 73827 should be revoked.
