THIRD ORDER EXTENDING TIME

National Communication Systems, Inc., (formerly Delta Mobile Radio Telephone Company) having requested in writing, on September 10, 1968, for an extension of the September 30, 1968 time limit mentioned in ordering paragraph No. 8 of Decision No. 70731, as established by Decision No. 74319, June 27, 1968, Second Order Extending Time, to March 30, 1969, because of the necessity of obtaining modified construction permits from the Federal Communications Commission, before operation can begin at Vallejo and Lake Tahoe, and it appearing to the Commission that a six-month extension should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with ordering paragraph No. 8 of Decision No. 70731 is extended to and including March 31, 1969.

In all other respects, Decision No. 70731 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
