## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Walnut Avenue and McKinley Avenue near Chino, County of San Bernardino, and Reservoir Street, Ficus Street and Towne Avenue in the City of Pomona, County of Los Angeles, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

Walnut Avenue BAB-517.81-C
Reservoir Street BAB-518.20-C
Ficus Street BAB-518.45-C

Towne Avenue BAB-518.70-C

It is alleged that McKinley Avenue is not at present open to public use and travel. This order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of

approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be as follows:

Flashing Light Signals
Supplemented with Automatic
Gate Arms (General Order No. 75-B)

Walnut Avenue

Two (2)

Reservoir Street

Four (4)

Ficus Street

Two (2)

Towne Avenue

Four (4)

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Trains shall not be operated over the crossings until such protection is placed in service.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
