O R D E R

The Southern Pacific Company, in connection with the construction of Hunter Industrial Park in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, is hereby authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across the locations as listed below and substantially as shown by plans (No. B-5098, sheets 1,2,3) attached to the application, with protection provided as follows:

BJ-544.91-C	Marlborough Ave.	Level	40 Ft.	2 Stand. No. 8 Fl. Lt. Signals

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation, with top of rails flush with the roadway. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
