SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 74608, the Commission authorized National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, on behalf of various common carriers, to publish specific revisions in Supplement 6 to its National Motor Freight Classification A-10 (Governing Classification) effective October 3, 1968.

Certain items containing commodity descriptions in the Gypsum and Gypsum Products Group of the Governing Classification were renumbered in this supplement. The Commission's Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 sets forth truckload exception ratings and minimum weights for the articles described in the above commodity group but refers to the canceled item numbers of the Governing Classification for a specific description of the commodities in question. A minor change not related to the matter in this proceeding will be included in the changes made herein.¹

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds, that references in Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 to item numbers in the Governing Classification for descriptions of the commodities involved should correspond with the item numbers assigned to such commodities in the Governing Classification. The Commission concludes that Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 should be amended accordingly.

¹Items Nos. 1040, 1060, 1120, 1160 and 1180 of ERT No. 1 are being amended to eliminate Items Nos. 34800, 42190, 42200, 91820, 91840, 169480 and 193900 of the Governing Classification. Reference to Items Nos. 91850, 91870, 91890, 91930, 91950, 91960 and 91970 of the Governing Classification will be inserted in Item No. 1120 of ERT No. 1. The change not related to this proceeding corrects an inadvertent omission of reference to Item No. 151390 of the Governing Classification in Item No. 1160 of ERT No. 1 with respect to the commodity description on waste paper.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective October 12, 1968, Supplement No. 1 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and shall be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than October 12, 1968; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the tariff supplement incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the provisions authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations;

such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the provisions published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
