OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant, R. L. Mohr, dba Advanced Electronics, pursuant to Decision No. 66101, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a two-way radiotelephone utility system to provide service to the South Bay communities in the County of Los Angeles, all as more fully described in the application as amended.

Decision No. 66101, as modified by Decision No. 66702, further provided that upon filing of an application and a showing that a construction permit and license has been issued by the Federal Communications Commission to applicant, and that applicant has secured the necessary permits from local authorities to construct transmitting facilities at the proposed site, an appropriate order shall issue granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise all rights and privileges granted under said construction permit and license.

By letters dated August 13, 1968, and September 4, 1968, applicant avers that:

1. Applicant has been issued Federal Communications Commission Construction Permit, File No. 214-C2-P-63, under Date of Grant June 26, 1968 and filed August 14, 1968.

2. Applicant has been issued SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 1554-(2) by the Regional Planning Commission, County of Los Angeles, dated March 6, 1964 and filed March 10, 1964, and construction of a radio transmission facility on subject property was completed prior to March 1, 1965 and that said facility has been maintained and operated since that time.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission is of the opinion, and so finds, that applicant has complied with all required conditions contained in Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 66101, as modified by Decision No. 66702; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

R. L. Mohr, dba Advanced Electronics, be and hereby is granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise all rights and privileges granted under the permits set forth in Findings Nos. 1 and 2 set forth herein.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
