ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Commission by Decision No. 74698 issued September 17, 1968 in the above entitled matter, authorized the requested transfer to be consummated on or before November 1, 1968. Extension of the time to November 15, 1968 because of the absence from the state of the seller has been requested in writing. The relief sought appears to be justified and will be granted.

"1. On or before November 15, 1968, Pershing L. Reiner may sell and transfer and Ishmei D. Sumner, Edison D. Sumner and T. Durbin Thompson may purchase and acquire the operative rights and property referred to in the application."
