Application of City of Compton, a MUNICIPAL COTPORATION, TO CONSTRUCT crossing over the Southern Pacific Company's Long Beach Line, subject to provisions of Sections 1201-1205 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California.

<u>order</u>

City of Compton is hereby authorized to construct Palmer Street at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company in Compton, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 6L-10.77.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 80 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

Construction expense of the crossing and installation expense of the crossing protection shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement entered into between the applicant and Southern Pacific Company. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne equally between the applicant and Southern Pacific Company, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Upon completion, Crossing No. 6L-10.55, about 900 feet northerly shall be abandoned and effectively closed. Within thirty

days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
