OPINION AND ORDER

A certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a freight forwarder was granted to Airways Parcel Post Service, Inc., doing business as Airways Air Freight (Airways), by Decision No. 73808 dated March 5, 1968. By Decision No. 74601 dated August 27, 1968, paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 73808 was amended to provide for the establishment of service and filing of tariffs within one hundred eighty days rather than one hundred twenty days as originally provided in Decision No. 73808. The final date to establish the service and file tariffs was September 21, 1968.

By Petition for Modification filed October 4, 1968, Airways requests a further extension of time within which to file its tariff and establish service. The petition alleges that by reason of unexpected complications arising in connection with the development of a suitable rate structure, completion of the printing of a tariff was not accomplished in time to file it with the Commission by September 21, 1968. Certain personnel in charge of tariffs and rates suddenly left the employment of petitioner, necessitating a new rate study and construction of a tariff. This work is now substantially completed and printing of a tariff is in process.

The Commission having considered such request, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 73808 as amended by Decision No. 74601 is further amended as follows:

2(b) On or before November 30, 1968, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
