SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 74706, dated September 24, 1968, authorized the City of Los Angeles to construct a spur track at grade across the Wilmington-San Pedro Road in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. GMA-21.60-C.

The above decision required the crossing to be protected by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order 75-B) augmented with automatic gates. The applicant, by letter dated September 30, 1968, has requested authorization to permit the Harbor Belt Line Railroad to operate over the crossing prior to the installation of the automatic protection for a 60 day period commencing on October 15, 1968 with protection by lighted fuses on each side of the crossing.

IT IS ORDERED that the Harbor Belt Line Railroad may operate over the Wilmington-San Pedro Road Crossing No. GMA-21.60-C with interim protection by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet

material. No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing unless first brought to a stop and a lighted fusee placed on each approach of the road. This authority shall expire on December 13, 1968 or when the automatic gates are installed, whichever occurs first.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
