O P I N I O N

Greyhound Lines, Inc., has applied herein to revise several of its routes and to revoke one route which will be replaced by a new route over Interstate Highway 680. It is alleged that there will be no change in scheduling and no increase in fares. It is further alleged that the proposed changes will be in the public interest and will not affect the operations of any other passenger carrier.

After consideration, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Greyhound Lines, Inc., authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Fifth Revised Pages 28 and 29 and First Revised Page 29-A, attached hereto, as an extension and

enlargement of, consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section III of Appendix A thereof.

2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating Fifth Revised Page 28 and Fifth Revised Page 29 and First Revised Page 29-A in revision of Fourth Revised Pages 28 and 29 and Original Page 29-A.

3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations. Failure so to do may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. Applicant is placed on notice that, if it accepts the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, it will be required, among other things, to comply with and observe the safety rules of the California Highway Patrol, the rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98-A and insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101-B.
- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.

- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98-A.

The effective date of this order shall be five days after the date hereof.

12.05 - Between Washington Avenue Overcrossing and Foothill Junction:

From junction California Highway 17 and California Highway 238 (Washington Avenue Overcrossing), over California Highway 238 to junction Interstate Highway 580 (Foothill Junction).

12.06 - Intentionally left blank.

12.07 - Between San Mateo and Hayward:

From San Mateo, over California Highway 92 via San Mateo Toll Bridge to Hayward, to be operated as an alternate route.

\*12.08 - Between Alamo Canal Junction and West Pleasanton:

From junction Interstate Highways 580 and 680 (Alamo Canal Junction), over Interstate Highway 680 to junction unnumbered highway (West Pleasanton).

12.09 - Between West Dublin Junction and East Dublin Junction:

From junction Interstate Highway 580 and unnumbered highway west of Dublin (West Dublin Junction), over unnumbered highway to junction Interstate Highway 580 east of Dublin (East Dublin Junction).

12.10 - Between Dublin and South Dublin Junction:

From Dublin over California Highway 21 to junction Interstate Highway 580 (South Dublin Junction).

12.11 - Between Wood's Corner and Parks Air Force Base (Main Gate):

From Wood's Corner, over Daugherty Road to Parks Air Force Base (Main Gate).

Service is authorized to be conducted in Special Operations only.

12.12 - Between Santa Rita and Pleasanton:

From Santa Rita, over unnumbered highway to Pleasanton, to be operated as an alternate route.

12.13 - Between West Freeway Junction (Livermore) and East Freeway Junction (Livermore):

From junction Interstate Highway 580 and unnumbered highway northwest of Livermore (West Freeway Junction), over unnumbered highway to junction California Highway 84 (Livermore), thence over California Highway 84 to junction Interstate Highway 580 (East Freeway Junction).

\*12.14 - Between Livermore and San Jose:

From Livermore, over unnumbered highway via Pleasanton to junction Interstate Highway 680 (West Pleasanton), thence over Interstate Highway 680 to junction California Highway 238 (North Mission Junction), thence over California Highway 238 to San Jose.

Authority is granted to serve Sunol Junction over available access highways to Interstate Highway 680.

12.15 - Between Chrisman Road Junction and Vernalis Junction:

From junction U. S. Highway 50 and Interstate Highway 580 (Chrisman Road Junction), over Interstate Highway 580 to junction California Highway 132 (West Vernalis Junction), thence over California Highway 132 to junction California Highway 33 (Vernalis Junction).

\*12.16 - Between Westside Junction and Modesto:

From junction U. S. Highway 50 and California Highway 33 (Westside Junction), over California Highway 33 to Vernalis Junction, thence over California Highway 132 to Modesto.

From Vernalis Junction, over California Highway 33 to junction California Highway 207 (Volta Junction), thence over California Highway 207 to junction California Highway 152 (Los Banos).
