 on 12th Street in the Fortuna area.)

ORDER

The County of Humboldt is hereby authorized to widen the crossing of 12th Street at grade with a track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, Crossing No. 5-265.6, near Fortuna in Humboldt County, as described and substantially as shown in Exhibit "A" attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Construction expense of the widened crossing shall be borne by the applicant. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
