ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

By Decision No. 74770 dated October 1, 1968 in Case No. 8812 the Commission found the operations of Cable Flying Service, Inc. were not subject to the provisions of Public Utilities Code sections 2740-2769.5. By Decision No. 73119 dated September 26, 1967 in the above numbered application, Cable Flying Service, Inc. was issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity by this Commission pursuant to Public Utilities Code section 2754.

Good cause appearing, Cable Flying Services, Inc. is directed to appear before the Commission at a hearing to be held in the Commission Courtroom, Los Angeles, California, on Wednesday, January 15, 1969, and show cause, if any there be, why the certificate issued to it by Decision No. 73119 should not be revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of this order to be made upon Cable Flying Service, Inc. forthwith.
