SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Interlines-Blankenship Warehouse Co., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at San Leandro.

Interlines-Blankenship Warehouse Co. has submitted to this Commission amended Articles of Incorporation changing the corporate name of the company to Overmyer of San Leandro. Accordingly, the operative right will be amended to show the new corporate name and the warehouseman will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 61-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 69397 dated July 13, 1965, in Application No. 47602 is hereby amended by substituting "Overmyer of San Leandro" in place and stead of "Interlines-Blankenship Warehouse Co."

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and

the public, Overmyer of San Leandro shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.2 of General Order No. 61-A.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Overmyer of San Leandro, or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent, and R. B. Daugherty, Standard Oil Building, 225 Bush Street, San Francisco, CA 94104.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
