O R D E R

The Union Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to construct industrial spur tracks at grade across the locations listed below in the County of Los Angeles, substantially as shown by plans (Nos. F-1089-A, C, B, sheets 1, 2, 3) attached to the application, with protection provided as follows:

3A-18.0-C	Dominguez St.	2%	62 Ft.	2 Std. No. 3 Fl. Lt. Signals
3A-18.3-C	Santa Fe Ave.	2%	84 Ft.	2 Std. No. 3 Fl. Lt. Signals supplemented with add'l. Fl. Lights on Cantilever Arms.
3A-18.4-C	Santa Fe Ave.	2%	84 Ft.	2 Std. No. 3 Fl. Lt. Signals supplemented with add'l. Fl. Lights on Cantilever Arms.

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation,

with top of rails flush with the roadway. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant seeks immediate authority in order to avoid expensive delays in construction. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
