SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 74964 dated November 19, 1968, in the above proceeding, the Commission granted increases in the minimum rates and charges named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8 for the statewide transportation of fresh or green fruits and vegetables and related commodities by for-hire highway carriers. Such increased minimum rates are scheduled to become effective January 1, 1969.

Through inadvertence, the 2,000, 4,000, 10,000 and 20,000-pound distance rates in Item No. 300 and the Column C rate on pears in boxes weighing 40 pounds or more in Item No. 610 of Tariff No. 8 were not increased to reflect the authority granted by Decision No. 74964, supra.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary corrections should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8 should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8 (Appendix "C" to Decision No. 33977, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective January 1, 1969, Nineteenth Revised Page 29 and Third Revised Page 42-I, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. The tariff amendments established in Ordering Paragraph 1 hereof may also be established by common carriers in connection with the transportation of:

- (a) commodities for which minimum rates have not been established, or
- (b) commodities which are subject to higher rates than, or more restrictive provisions than, the minimum rates or provisions otherwise applicable.

3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than January 1, 1969; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and

to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates and charges authorized hereinabove, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates and charges published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects Decision No. 33977, as amended, and Decision No. 74964 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective December 13, 1968.
