FOURTH ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to install the automatic protection in connection with the authority granted in Decision No. 67156, alleging that the city's design of proposed widening and channelization, which will necessitate a change in crossing protection, has not been finalized. However, it is now agreed by the parties that the improved automatic protection will be installed on an interim basis and later relocated.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision is hereby extended to October 30, 1969.

In all other respects, Decision No. 67156 shall remain in full force and effect.
