ORDER OF DISMISSAL

During the course of hearing before Examiner Daly on November 12, 1968, at San Francisco, counsel for Skymark Airlines, Inc. requested dismissal of the instant application to serve the Truckee-Tahoe Airport (Martis Valley) on a flag stop basis.

By letter dated November 7, 1968 (Exhibit No. 2), counsel for applicant informed the Commission that commencing November 18, 1968, applicant intended to inaugurate service to Reno, Nevada, and as a consequence would no longer be subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission. Applicant was placed upon notice that its present intrastate authority could be the subject of a Commission investigation leading to revocation.
