ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant seeks exemption under Section 2767 of the Public Utilities Code from the certification requirements of Sections 2752 and 2754 in conducting passenger operations between Orange County Airport and Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), and between Ventura County Airport and LAX.

This application was based upon the theory that applicant was subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission and that emergency conditions existed in the Los Angeles area because at the time of the application the only helicopter service provided in the area was indefinitely suspended.

The records of this Commission show that applicant now provides a regular scheduled service carrying passengers on an individual fare basis for compensation by aircraft between LAX and Lake Havasu, Arizona, and between Ontario and Lake Havasu, Arizona. On October 1, 1968, this Commission determined that it had no certificating jurisdiction over the applicant due to such interstate operations.<sup>1</sup> ✓
