O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct East Center Street at grade across the tracks of the Yreka Western Railroad Company in the City of Yreka, County of Siskiyou, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 47-7.4.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 28 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material and two-train actuated floodlights.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of outside rails. Yreka Western Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Upon completion, the following crossings shall be abandoned and effectively closed:
