ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 71884 dated January 24, 1967, in Application No. 48822, Millard E. Divine and Walter L. Entler, doing business as Chico Transit Lines, were authorized to acquire passenger stage operative rights authorizing service in the City of Chico and vicinity and between Chico, Paradise and Oroville and intermediate points, and it appearing that during the month of June 1968, Millard E. Divine and Walter L. Entler, without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by them pursuant to the foregoing described operative rights, and that since November 3, 1968, Millard E. Divine and Walter L. Entler have had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-B and that Millard E. Divine has informed the Commission that they will be unable to resume service because of financial difficulties; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, granted by Decision No. 71884 in Application No. 48822, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the

Commission in the name of Millard E. Divine and Walter L. Entler are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Millard E. Divine and Walter L. Entler or to mail a certified copy thereof to Millard E. Divine and Walter L. Entler at Route 1, Box 404, Chico, California 95926, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 20th day after such service upon Millard E. Divine and Walter L. Entler or after the above mailing to Millard E. Divine and Walter L. Entler, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
