OPINION AND ORDER

In Case No. 8801, complainants Harry H. Morse and Mildred B. Morse seek an order (1) requiring defendants Luis S. King and Nancy Johnson, doing business as Pine Mountain Water Company, to carry out their obligations with regard to providing service to complainants' Rainbow Ranch properties in Tulare County or (2) reopening complainants' former application for a certificate covering the Rainbow Ranch properties.

Application No. 48476, the proceeding in which defendants in Case No. 8801 were granted a certificate covering the Rainbow Ranch properties, and Application No. 48639, the proceeding in which complainants in Case No. 8801 were denied a certificate covering the Rainbow Ranch properties, were reopened so that the previous decision in those proceedings might be reconsidered in the light of the evidence to be presented in Case No. 8801.

By letter dated November 12, 1968, complainants in Case No. 8801 advised the Commission that the complaint had been satisfied and requested dismissal of the complaint. This obviates the need for reconsideration of the decision in the two related applications.

Based upon the letter request of complainants,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Case No. 8801 is dismissed.
2. Decision No. 74402, dated July 16, 1968, reopening Applications Nos. 48476 and 48639, is rescinded.
